#### Sensex boost by 110 Points:

Mumbai - A Smart recovery in Pharma shares and select Information Technology (IT) counters lifted the market index by about 110 points at BSE on hectic buying by speculators and foreign funds.

Pharma scrips highlighed trading on news that the International Finance Corporation has decided to focus on IT, pharmaceuticals, health care and education sectors rather than manufacturing sector.

Several IT counters such as Wipro, Satyam Computers, HCL, Silver Line, Huges Software, Polaris software and Sonata software continued to strengthen on persistent FII buying, in BSE sensitive index closed at 5835.40 having a handsome gain from previous closing levels of 5725.50.

The BSE-100 index flared up by 130.19 points to 3649.37.
