8 Case Study: $7 \times 2 = 14$

A group of final year students are planning to have a party to celebrate the end of the college year. Their plan is to hold the party at the parking lot of the college or volleyball court; but if it rains, they will hold it in the garage operated by the parent of the college captain. Invitation has been informal; and they are not sure how many students have been actually invited. Everyone will bring his or her own alcohol, although a few of the people will be under 21. The vice college captain with a sound system is bringing it along; and they have decided to charge everyone who attends Rupees 400/ to cover their costs. The Language manager whose parent runs a catering company will provide food and will charge Rupees 200/ per plate.

As an event manager; analyse and answer the following questions from the legal compliance point of view:

- (i) Is permission required to use the parking lot, and if so, from whom?
- (ii) What are the implications of charging an entry fee? Would you recommend this?
- (iii) Should the police be told about the party? If so, indicate the reasons.

- (vi) What would happen if a fault in wiring caused someone to be electrocuted?
